MEMBERSHIP

The membership will be open to all persons with a genuine interest in the abandoned Brindley Village its legacy and that of the military hospital the preceded it.

AIMS AND OBJECTVES

- To inform visitors and members of the local community of the history of the area that was Brindley Village, the location of which was on Brindley Road, not to be confused with the more recently named area located at Brindley Heath Road.
- To preserve, for future generations, a documented history of both the place and the community.
- To give groups and individuals the opportunity to enter into a dialogue.
- To make the link between the physical features of the WW1 Military Hospital and explore its transformation to a village.
- To collect and record artefacts associated with village and hospital.
- To acknowledge and encourage the interest of people in the history of Brindley Village and surrounding area.
- To pursue original research that can be made available to all.
- To mount an exhibition related to a timeline of the place and the community.
- To gather oral histories
- To publish written information as the opportunity arises
- To hold regular informal meetings that will promote related dialogue across the generations.

PROCEDURE

- Publicise and promote the work of the group and organise meetings and events related to the topic.
 - Invite contributions from local people and groups.
 - Utilise the work of volunteers as necessary.
 - Collate documents and photographs to form an archive.
 - Produce displays and exhibitions
 - Produce and maintain a contact network of people associated with Brindley Village.
 - Encourage volunteers to take proactive role within the group.

The management committee will manage the groups work, make decisions and direct policy making.

MEETINGS.

- The committee will meet as often as deems necessary.
- Informal group meetings will take place at least three times a year.
- An annual general meeting will occur no longer than fifteen months apart.
- Three committee member will need to be in attendance to form a quorum.

FINANCE

- There will be no charge to be a member of the group.
- All monies raised by or on behalf of the group shall be applied to the stated objectives of the Group and to no other purpose.
- Any income/expenditure will be the responsibility of the committee, who will ensure that the funds are utilised effectively.
- No income or profits generated by this group will be distributed to its members.
- The management will open a bank account in the name of the group.
- Any money received via grants or from any other source will be paid into that account only.
- Any cheques relating to bank account will have to be signed by two named signatories.
- Official accounts will be maintained and examined once a year by an independent accountant, who is not a member of the group.

OWNERSHIP RIGHTS

- Any resources or materials obtained and/or published by the group will remain the property of the Group.
- Copying or publication of any material in the guardianship of the group will only be permitted with consent of the committee.
- Permission of the owner must be sought and gained, where possible, before photographic material is used for display.
- Any comment opinion or photographic records given to the press or social media can only be deemed to be that of the individual, unless the content has been discussed and agreed by the committee.

ALTERING THE CONSTITUTION

Any change to the constitution must be agreed by 80% of the members.

DISSOLUTION

- The Group may be dissolved if deemed necessary by a majority of the members.
- Any remaining assets or funds after all debts have been paid shall be given or transferred to other charitable institutions, or institution, or other non-profit organisation having similar objectives to those of this Legacy Group.
- Where any property or equipment has been loaned to the Group or project by individuals, or organisations, this shall be returned to them. If return is not required then all such property will be donated to a not-forprofit organisation with similar aims
- Artefacts and written material will be offered to the local Record Office and Museum

1. WHAT DOES YOUR ORGANISATION DO AND HOW DOES IT BENEFIT THE RESIDENTS OF HEDNESFORD?

We organise an annual competitive music festival at which local people [mainly young people in the 8-20 age range] can perform to show their musical talents. This is not a 'pop' festival but gives a platform to those learning vocals and/or more orchestral type instruments e.g. piano, violin, clarinet etc. The performers enter different classes [see last year's schedule – enclosed]. This helps encourage youngsters to keep up their music lessons and nurtures young singers and instrumentalists. The professional adjudicators give detailed feedback, help and advice to every competitor.

5. PLEASE GIVE DETAILS OF THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE YOU WORK WITH/PROVIDE SERVICES FOR? HOW MANY ARE RESIDENTS IN HEDNESFORD?

We average about 220 entries per year. Some come from beyond Hednesford e.g. Cannock and Walsall. We have a reputation within the Festival circuit as a good quality and friendly Festival so we do get some entrants from further afield e.g. Sutton Coldfield and on some occasions we have had entrants from The Isle of Man! This is good for the local entrants to see/hear from people outside of their normal circle of people. Probably about half of entrants are from the Hednesford area.

6. BRIEFLY DESCRIBE THE PROJECT OR PURPOSE FOR WHICH YOU REQUIRE A GRANT PLEASE STATE HOW IT WILL BENEFIT THE LOCAL COMMUNITY OF HEDNESFORD.

The purpose is to enable us to keep this long running and valuable Festival in existence. Hopefully if the national financial situation improves in a year or two we can then increase fees and attract more commercial sponsorship.

We have enough funds to run this year [October 13 2018] but we are struggling to maintain the event. There are quite a few costs in running the Festival at a professional standard We hire the school [previously called Blake but now Staffordshire University Academy] at a reduced cost, we have to hire 3 pianos as the school ones are not of sufficient quality (about £650), we have to pay for the three professional adjudicators and in some cases their expenses and overnight stay (about £900), accompanists are required (about £400) plus costs of printing syllabuses and programmes, insurance etc.

We could increase entry fees but fear that the increases would penalise the youngsters in the present economic situation bearing in mind the families will already be paying for music lessons.

7. WHAT IS THE AMOUNT OF GRANT YOU ARE SEEKING?

Any help would be appreciated but if we have to put a figure on what we would hope for it would be £100. While we can just about cover running costs we require two more trophies/shields. To get value for money we would look at reasonably robust items in the region of £50 each. If you supported this we would have the Trophies/Shields engraved as the Hednesford Town Council Trophy [or whatever wording you require]. These trophies would then be presented year on year.

8. WHAT IS THE TOTAL COST OF THE PROJECT/ANNUAL BUDGET FOR WHICH YOU ARI SEEKING A GRANT?

In 2017 we spent £2459 per annum, fortunately we obtained more donations but mostly on a one-off basis [see accounts sheet attached]

See 9 above. We currently charge £7.50 - £8.50 per entry plus we also charge an entry fee on the door of £1.50 for those coming with the competitor. We produce a programme we charge £1.50 for this [it costs about 50p to produce]. We serve refreshments which make a profit.

Dear Sir,

I am Chair of the Chadsmoor, Hednesford and District Music Festival which has been running now for 71 years. The Music Festival is not the Glastonbury type but a Competitive Music Festival in which competitors enter specific classes and are judged by professional adjudicators. Cups and certificates are awarded.

I have enclosed a copy of last year's programme so you can see what we do in a bit more detail. There is also a basic website at www.chadsmoormusicfestival.co.uk. Most of the entrants are children and local to the Midlands.

To stage this annual event to a professional level inevitably incurs expenses. We hire the school [previously called Blake but now Staffordshire University Academy] at a reduced cost, we have to hire 3 pianos as the school ones are not of sufficient quality (about £650), we have to pay for the three professional adjudicators and in some cases their expenses and overnight stay (about £1000), accompanists are required (about £500) plus costs of printing syllabuses and programmes, insurance etc.

We charge competitors an entry fee and visitors who come with the competitors are charged an entry fee, plus we charge for the printed programme. We try to keep costs down as the parents of the competitors quite likely already pay for music tuition and let's face it this area is not in the main very affluent. We have sponsorship from the school in that they charge us a basic hire charge to just cover their costs. South Staffordshire College have been printing our Certificates and Programmes for us. Last year Jessup Builders helped us with a financial contribution. Despite this income and help we are only just covering our costs.

So, you have now probably guessed the reason for my letter. Would your Company be prepared to sponsor this local event? This year we need an additional Trophy/Shield and to replace a very old battered trophy. To be cost effective we would wish to buy reasonably robust awards which can then be awarded year after year. The costs vary but we would be looking at items in the £40-£50 range if possible.

If you could sponsor us in this way the trophy/shield would be inscribed with your name, hence forward being the ???????? Trophy [or whatever wording you would prefer]. However, any form of sponsorship would be very welcome, e.g. a smaller donation.



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

We are the busiest CFR Scheme in the region attending over 1600 calls and over 240 cardiac arrest calls in the last 12 months.

So that we can continue to provide this support we are looking to purchase a new vehicle. This will require conversion into a response vehicle along with having the new CFR livery applied and as such will provide the team with a reliable vehicle to respond in.

Would it be possible to put this on the next council meeting agenda to be discussed?



Support Staffordshire is the local support and development agency providing infrastructure support to voluntary and community sector organisations in Staffordshire including the Cannock Chase District.

One of its key responsibilities is the management of the Voluntary Car Scheme. The Voluntary Car Scheme provides a door-to-door transport service for residents of Lichfield and Cannock Chase District, which includes Hednesford and the surrounding areas. The service is provided through the Support Staffordshire office based in Lichfield where clerical volunteers provide 35 hours per week organising the transport requests. A bank of volunteer drivers are utilised to provide transport for people in need of support.

The scheme also supports people to visit sick relatives or friends in hospitals or care homes.

During the period April 2017 to March 2018 we completed 3748 journeys for the whole project. 150 of these were requests from Hednesford residents.

The voluntary car scheme enables people to obtain transport for essential journeys whether it be to get to a doctor's appointment, visit chiropodists, dentists or opticians, therefore enabling them to remain independent in their own home and have a feeling of wellbeing and less isolation. Journeys to hospitals provide clients with the support of a door-to-door service at an anxious time and helps remove the worry of the transport element of the hospital visit.

The scheme is dependent on the time given by 7 volunteer clerical staff and 36 volunteer drivers, who not only give their time, but also provide their own cars. These volunteer opportunities give people the chance to 'give back' to their community whist increasing their confidence and improving their self-esteem.
