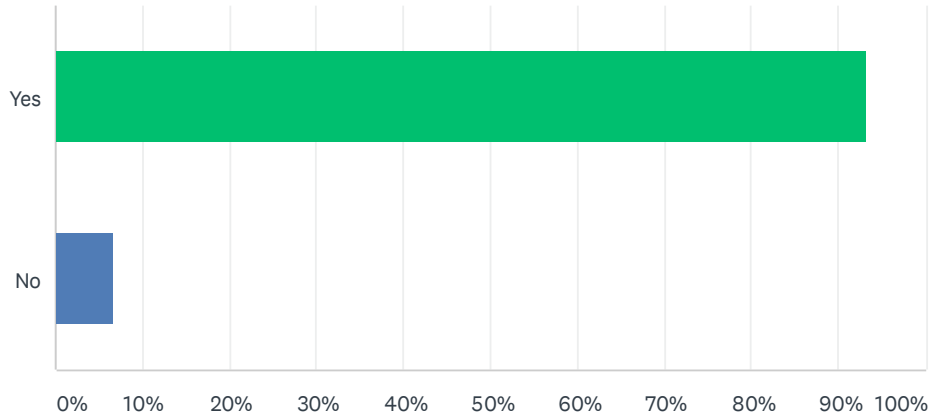


# Q1 Are you aware that Hednesford has a Community Centre?

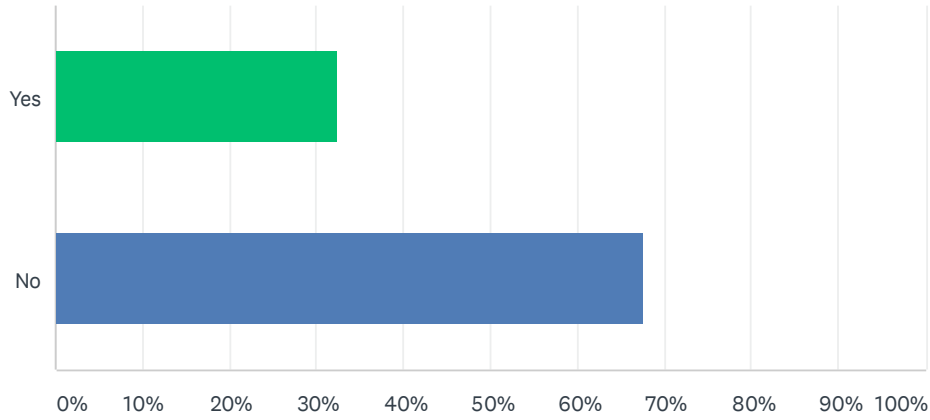

## Q2 Are you a regular user of Pye Green Community Centre?

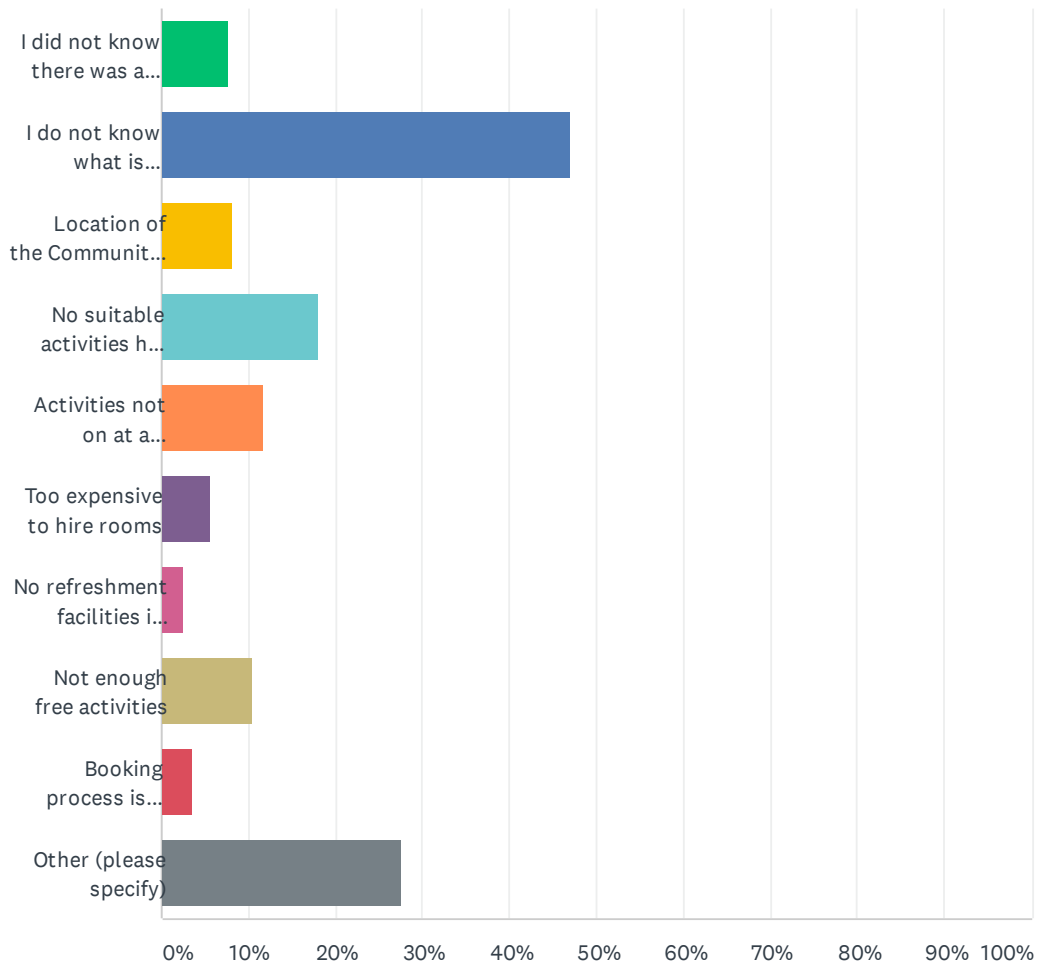

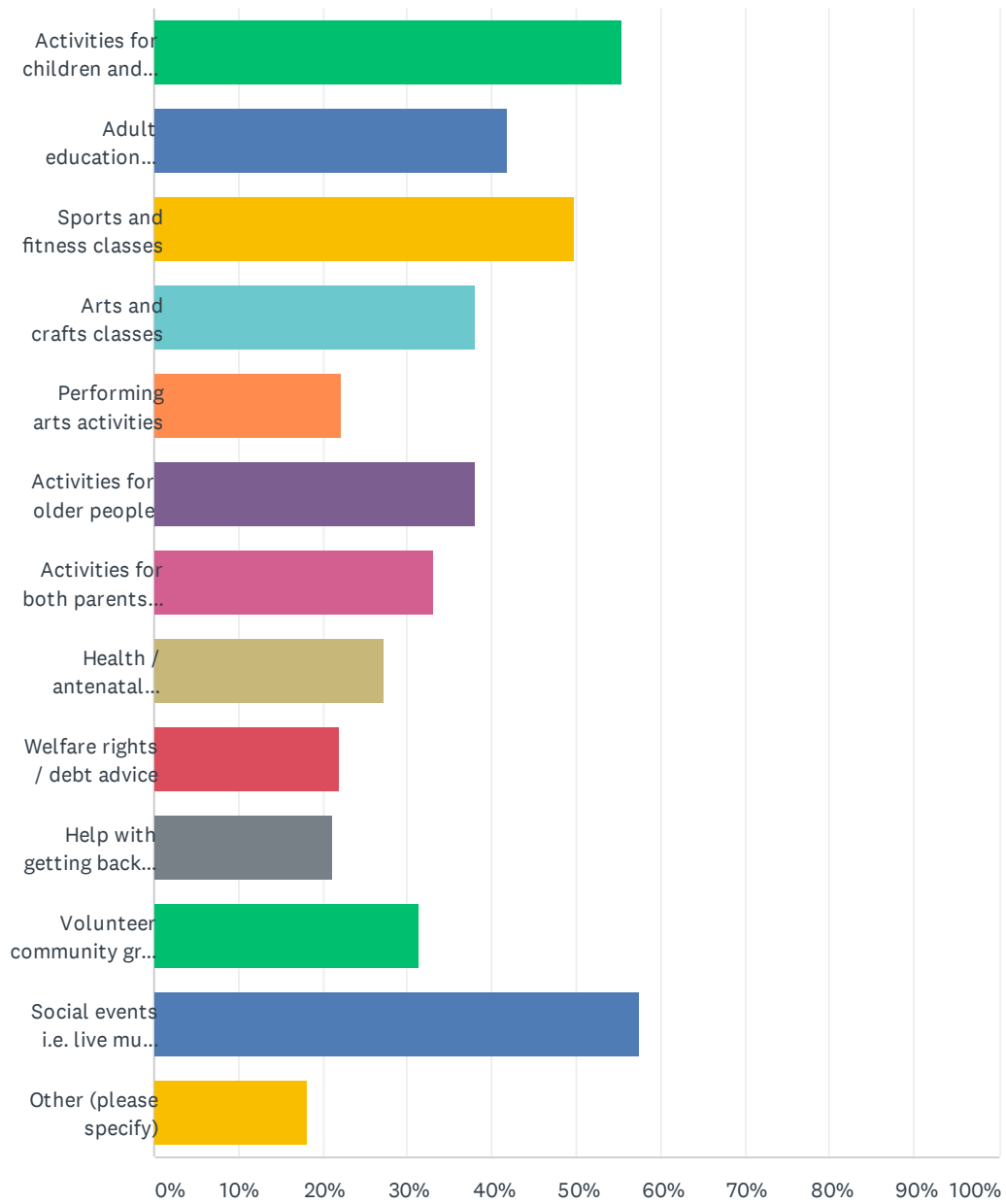

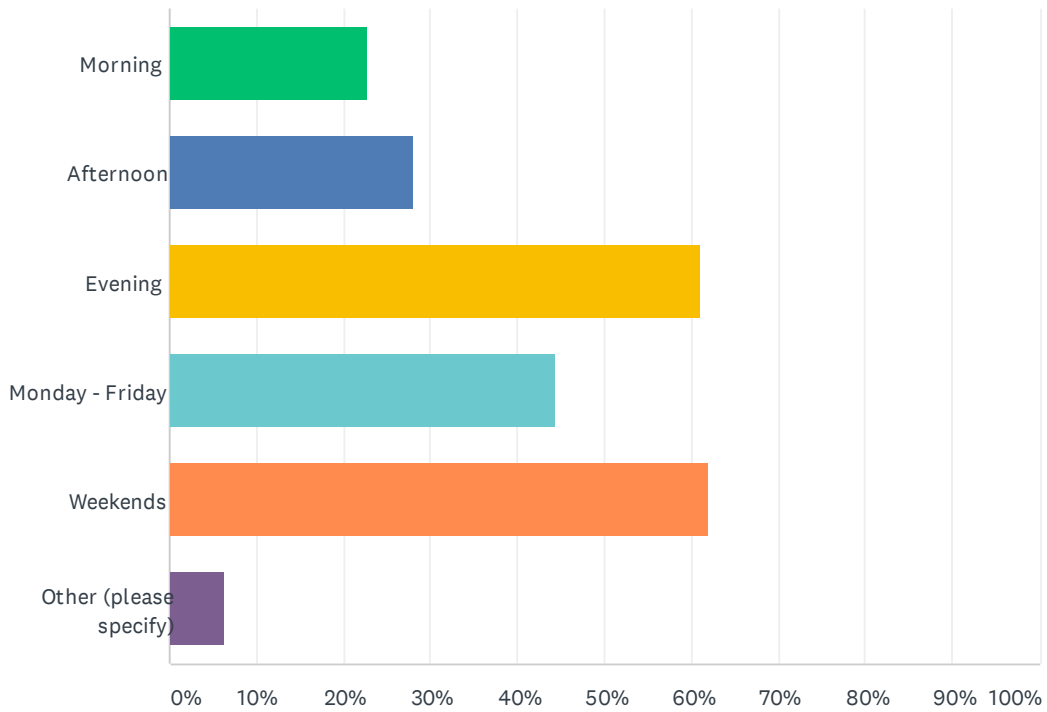

## Q5 What time of the day and week would you prefer to access services at the Community Centre?

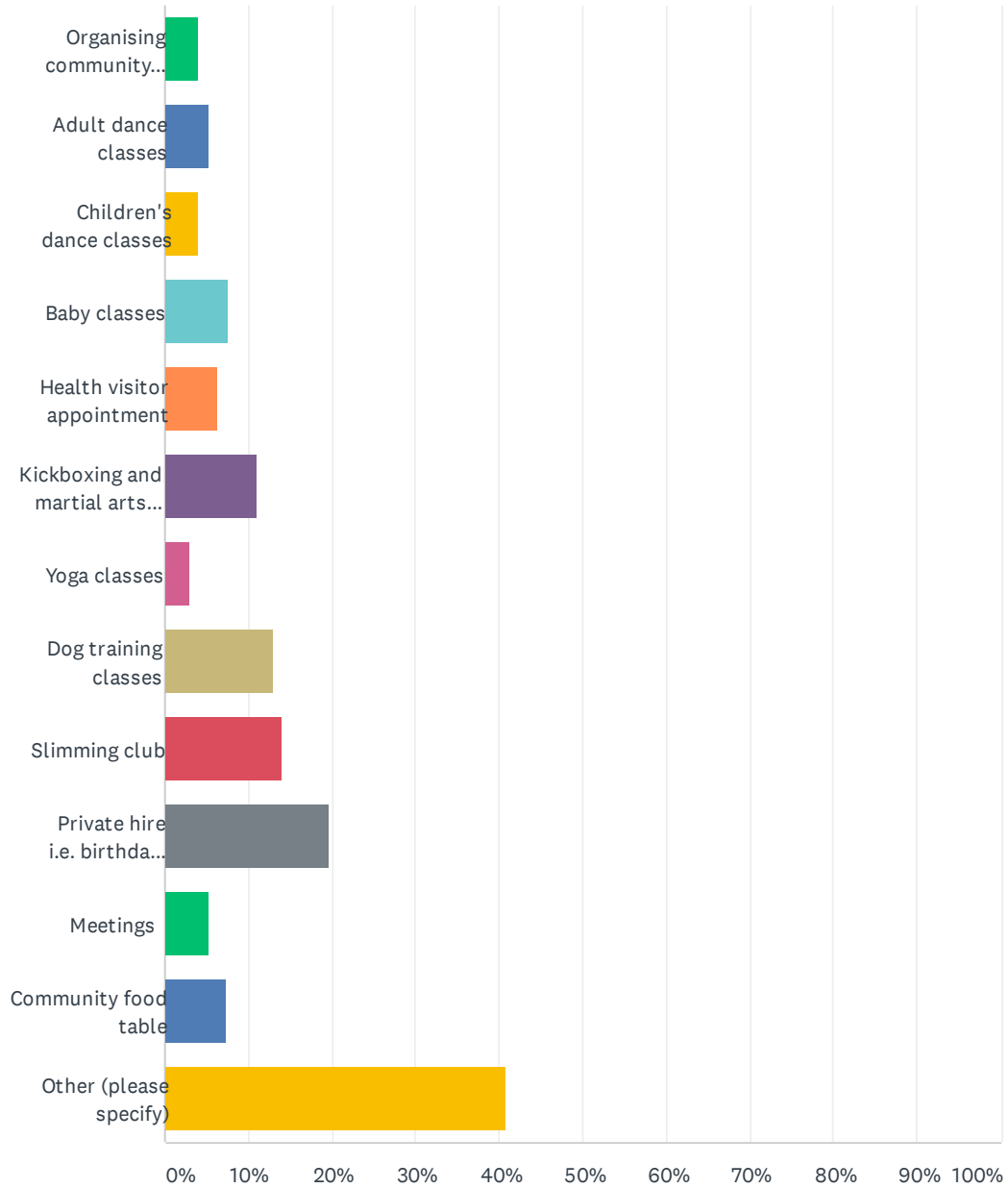

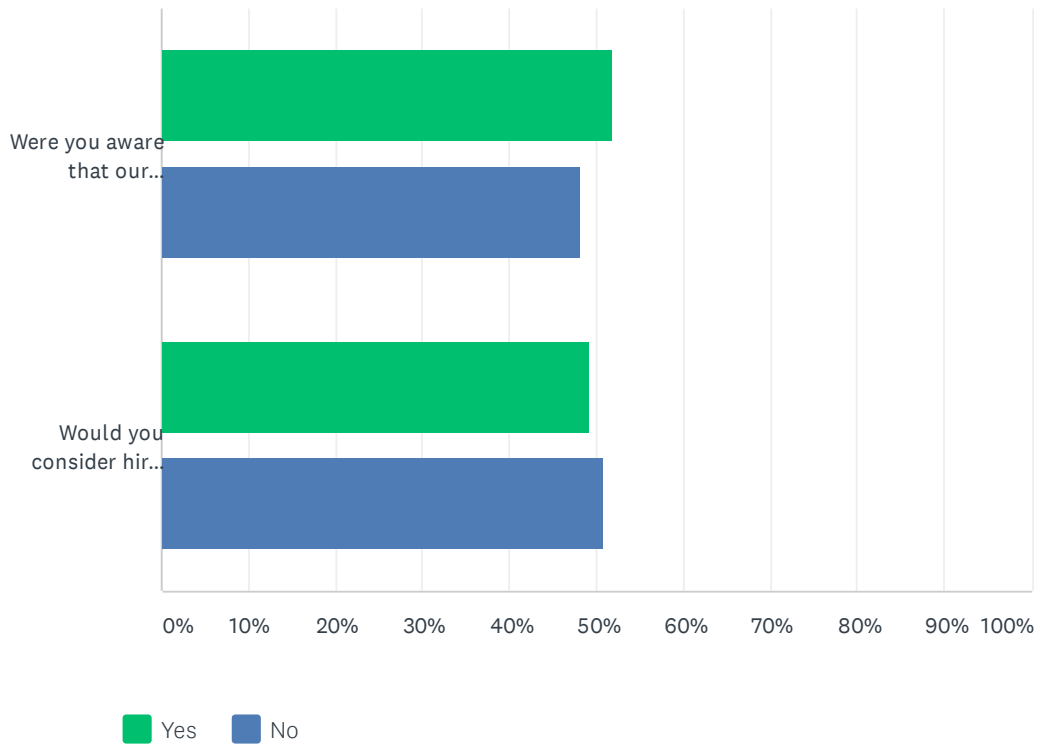

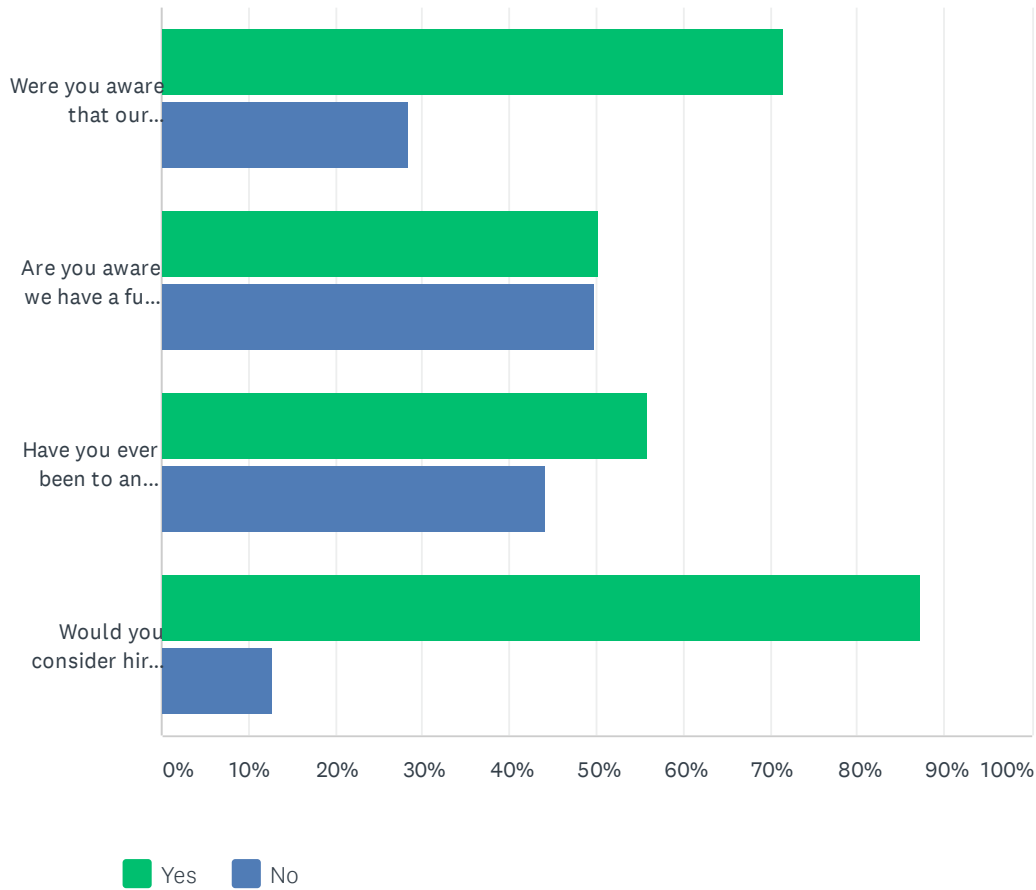

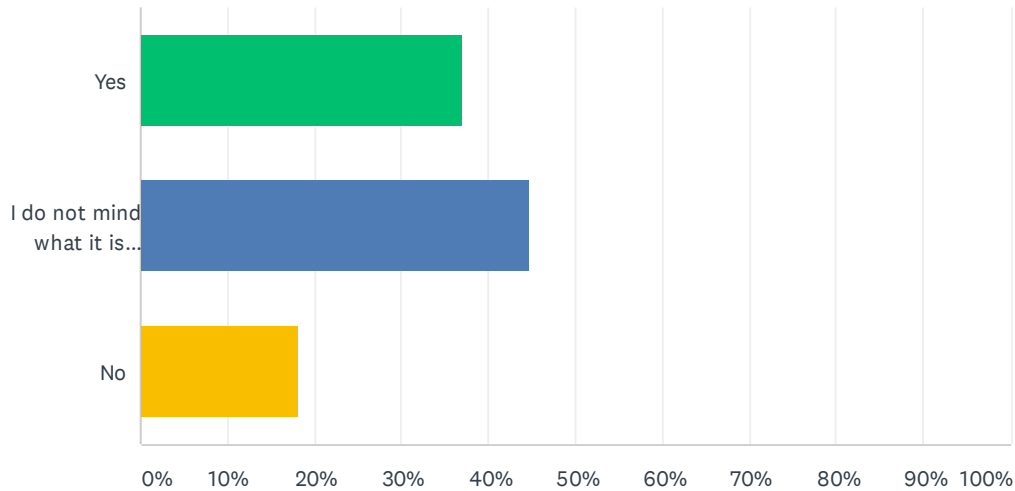

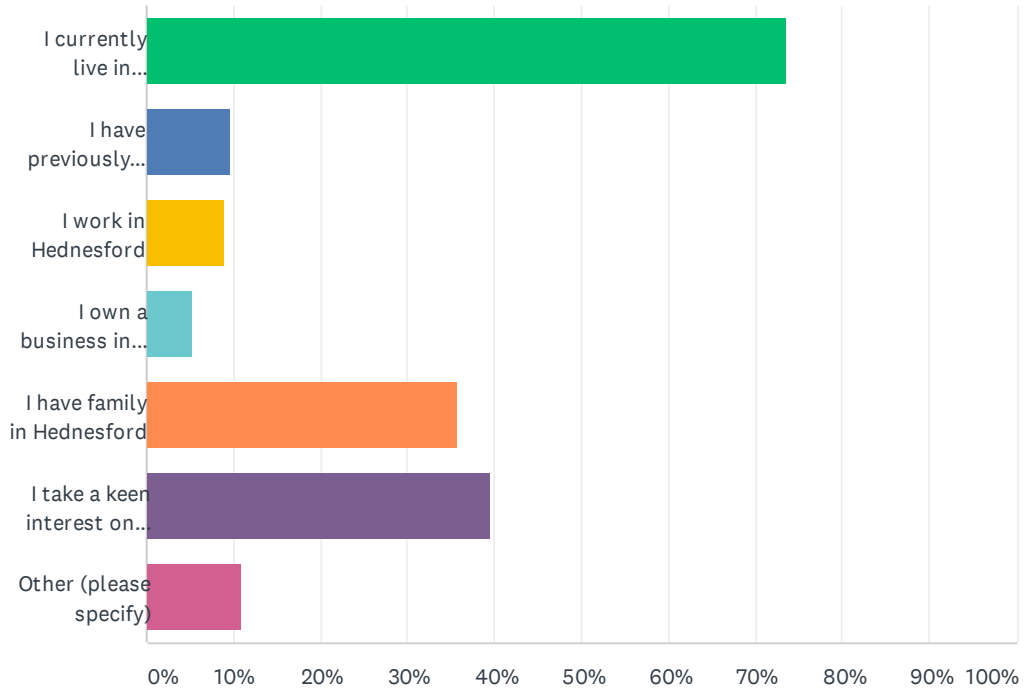

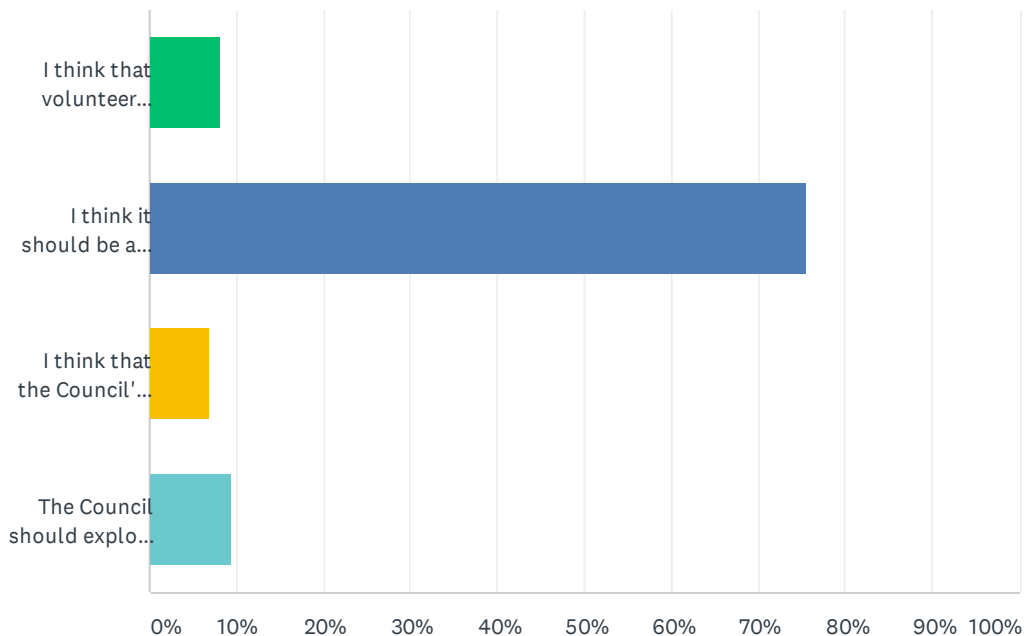

Q13 Cannock Chase District Council pay Hednesford Town Council a Precept, this is a small portion of your Council tax bill which is allocated to Hednesford Town Council to enable us to make beneficial changes and run town centre events. Current Hednesford Town Councillors inherited the running of the Community Centre, the running costs of which comprise of: 22% from the Precept = £44,000 Income from regular hirers = £40,000 Council reserves = £10,000 The Council are actively looking to increase the income of the Centre from private hire. The average household (Council tax Band D property) pays £7.77 per year / 15 pence per week towards the Community Centre. The remainder is made up from private hire of the Centre for activities listed in question 6, plus private functions. What would you like to see happen to the Community Centre in the future?

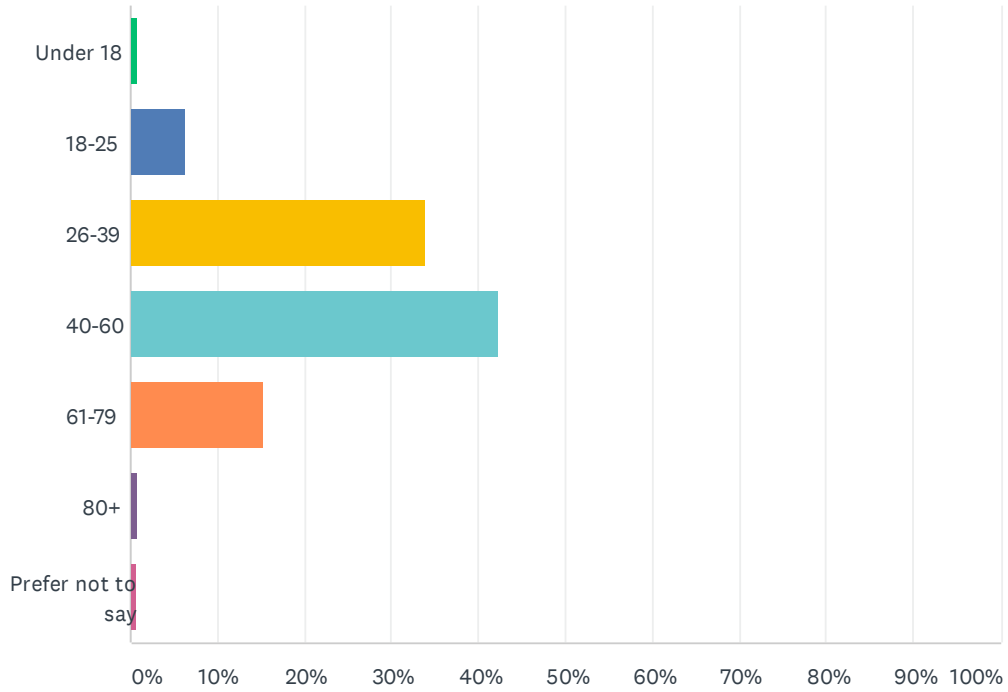

I think that volunteer community groups should have more use of the Community Centre, giving less time to private hirers. The increased cost could be met by either an increase in the Council tax paid by residents or by reducing spend in other areas	8.14%	48

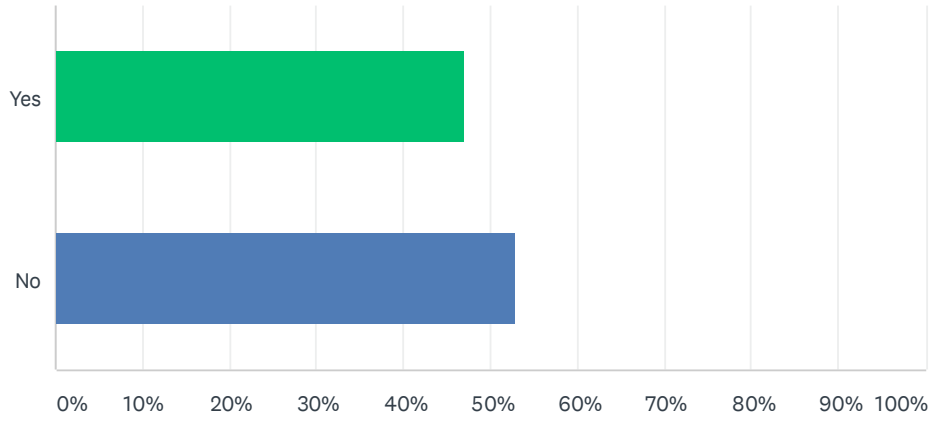
